We've reserved the Penn House conference room for Saturday, Sunday and Wednesday evenings; more information to follow in March.

INSTRUCTIONS: Please complete the form and return it with a check for \$150.00 written to WILPF and mail it to Claire Gosselin at the address shown below by March 15, 2009. This covers 5 nights at the Penn House. We urge participants to stay for the full training and lobby work, and in any case require \$150.00 payment for the accommodations as we have contractual obligations to the Penn House (and it's a good deal for Capitol Hill!).

Note: Staying at the Penn house is not required. Accommodations include bed linens, towels, and a simple breakfast each morning served from 8:05-8:35 AM. There is no kitchen use; however a refrigerator, toaster, and microwave are provided.
